Eligible students are paid up to 150 hours for each experience provided through our funders continuous support and communication from our staff.

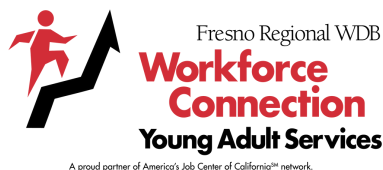
